WHEREAS, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors declares **OCTOBER 18 to 25, 2014** as **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK** in Alameda County; and

WHEREAS, the goal of **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK** is to promote the importance of building the capacity of all Californians to make good financial decisions to achieve their goals; connect consumers to money management resources in their communities; build relationships between organizations that provide money management resources and education with other organizations whose constituents need the support; and provide a framework for state, regional and local financial education groups to work in collaboration to highlight their programs and services; and


WHEREAS, during **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK**, state and local government agencies, non-profit organizations, unions, schools, libraries, financial institutions, and financial management associations will be working together in communities throughout California to host free money management education events and promote the importance of good money management practices; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County recognizes the importance of financial capability and access to money management education for all residents as an essential part of Alameda County's successful and thriving communities; and

WHEREAS, **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK** was started by the State Controller's Financial Literacy Advisory Committee, which is established by state law and charged with developing strategies to improve financial literacy. The Committee is composed of leaders in financial education and asset building in the private and non-profit sector; and

WHEREAS, **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK** is modeled after the Chicago Federal Reserve's Smart Money Week, held in 13 states.

THEREFORE, this Board of Supervisors, County of Alameda, State of California, does hereby proclaim **OCTOBER 18 to 25, 2014** as **MANAGE YOUR MONEY WEEK** in Alameda County and encourages all citizens to take the opportunity to enhance their money management skills.
