- (3) The CalWORKs Maintenance of Effort apportionment is the sum of a portion of Sales Tax, and Vehicle License Fees. Total apportioned on July 27, 2012: \$88,294,109.69.
- (4) The amount of the 2011-2012 Sales Tax Growth allocation is subject to change. The allocation date is yet to be determined.
