Enclosed is the Statement of General Fund Cash Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 1, 2012 through September 30, 2012. This statement reflects the State of California's General Fund cash position and compares actual receipts and disbursements for the 2012-13 Fiscal Year to cash flow estimates prepared by the Department of Finance for the 2012 Budget Act. The statement is prepared in compliance with Provision 7 of Budget Act item 0840-001-0001, using records compiled by the State Controller. Prior year actual amounts are also displayed for comparative purposes.

Current balance is comprised of \$9.6 billion carried forward from June 30, 2012 plus current year Net Increase/(Decrease) in Temporary Loans of \$12.7 billion.
