## RE: TRAVEL-PROHIBITED STATES FOR STATE-FUNDED AND STATE-SPONSORED TRAVEL

On Friday, July 14, 2023, the Office of the Attorney General added three states to the list of travel-prohibited states for all state-funded and state-sponsored travel: Missouri, Nebraska, and Wyoming. Per <u>Assembly Bill AB</u> 1887, the following states are currently subject to California's ban on state-funded and state-sponsored travel:

- South Dakota
- Tennessee
- Texas
- Utah
- West Virginia
- Wyoming NEW (Effective July 14, 2023)
