Jeff Burgh is the elected Auditor-Controller for Ventura County, and is responsible for overseeing an office with 76 budgeted positions and an annual operating budget of \$17 million. The Auditor-Controller's Office is responsible for establishing County fiscal and internal control policy and procedures; administering County payroll; conducting internal audits and Fraud Hotline investigations; performing mandated property tax functions; and the distribution of both vendor and public assistance payments. The office is also responsible for the issuance of the County's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report; Single Audit Report; and Tax Rates Report.

Mr. Burgh has over 27 years of public service, specializing in budget, finance, and accounting. He previously served Ventura County as Deputy Executive Officer, assisting the County CEO in the management of the Finance and Budget Division. He also served as Chief Deputy Non-Sworn, for the Ventura County Probation Agency, with oversight of Agency administrative functions.

Mr. Burgh received his Bachelor's degree majoring in Business Administration – Accounting Theory and Practice from CSU Northridge, and his Masters' of Public Policy and Administration from California Lutheran University, where he is currently a member of the graduate faculty in Public Policy, teaching on the subject of public budget and finance. He also served six years in the United States Army as a Resource Management Officer.
