The statement is prepared in compliance with Provision 5 of Budget Act item 0840-001-0001, using records compiled by the State Controller. Prior-year actual amounts are also displayed for comparative purposes.

Attachment A compares actual receipts and disbursements for the 2016-17 fiscal year to cash flow estimates prepared by DOF based upon the 2016-17 Budget Act.

- (a) A Statement of Estimated Cash Flow for the 2016-17 fiscal year was prepared by the Department of Finance for the 2016-17 Budget Act. Any projections or estimates are set forth as such and not as representation of facts.
- (b) Outstanding loan balance of \$10.53 billion is comprised of \$10.53 billion of internal borrowing. Current balance is comprised of \$646.2 million carried forward from June 30, 2016, plus current year Net Increase/(Decrease) in Temporary Loans of \$9.88 billion.
- (c) Negative amounts are the result of repayments received that are greater than disbursements made.
- (d) Debt Service amounts are net of offsets such as federal subsidies and reimbursements from other sources. To the extent that these offsets do not occur when anticipated, there can be variances between actuals and estimates on a month-to-month basis.
