The State Controller's Office reviewed claims submitted by the City of Santa Cruz under the Flood Control Subventions Program. Our review objective was to determine whether the costs claimed as presented in the attached Summary of Project Costs are allowable and in compliance with the California Department of Water Resources' Guidelines for State Reimbursement on Flood Control Projects. Our review was limited to validating consultant costs.

The city claimed costs of \$29,913 for the San Lorenzo River Flood Control project for the period of July 24, 2014, through November 10, 2014. Our review found that the entire amount is allowable.
