RE: PROHIBITED TRAVEL STATES FOR STATE-FUNDED AND STATE-SPONSORED TRAVEL

On Monday, August 29, 2022, the Office of the Attorney General added the following state to the list of travel-prohibited states for all state-funded and state-sponsored travel: Georgia. Per [Assembly Bill AB 1887](#), the following states are now identified as travel-prohibited states:

- Alabama
- Arizona – (Announced July 20, 2022; Effective September 28, 2022)
- Arkansas
- Florida
- Georgia – **NEW** (Effective August 19, 2022)
- Idaho
- Indiana
- Iowa
- Kansas
- Kentucky
- Louisiana
- Mississippi
- Montana
- North Carolina
- North Dakota
- Ohio
- Oklahoma
- South Carolina
- South Dakota
- Tennessee
- Texas
- Utah
- West Virginia
