**RE: PROHIBITED TRAVEL STATES FOR STATE-FUNDED AND STATE-SPONSORED TRAVEL**

On Wednesday, June 30, 2022, the Office of the Attorney General added the following states to the list of travel-prohibited states for all state-funded and state-sponsored travel: Arizona, Indiana, Louisiana, and Utah. Per [Assembly Bill AB 1887](#), the following states are now identified as travel-prohibited states:

- Arizona – **NEW** (Effective September 28, 2022)
- Indiana – **NEW** (Effective July 1, 2022)
- Louisiana – **NEW** (Effective August 1, 2022)
- Utah – **NEW** (Effective July 1, 2022)
- Alabama
- Arkansas
- Florida
- Idaho
- Iowa
- Kansas
- Kentucky
- Mississippi
- Montana
- North Carolina
- North Dakota
- Ohio
- Oklahoma
- South Carolina
- South Dakota
- Tennessee
- Texas
- West Virginia
