On February 22, 2006, the State Controller's Office (SCO) issued <u>Leave Letter 06-004</u>, announcing a new intermittent employee benefit automated tracking system within CLAS. Departments have been using this new process and have requested a report to identify intermittent time base employees who are eligible for certain benefits.

The SCO is pleased to announce that an Intermittent Benefit Tracking Report (IBT) will be available to assist CLAS departments in verifying employee eligibility for a Merit Salary Adjustment (MSA), Special In-grade Salary Adjustment (SISA), range change, retirement, health and dental benefits, probation hours, personal holiday/vacation waiting periods, maximum hours worked, and actual time worked (ATW). This report will identify those employees who are nearing or are eligible for one or more of the above benefits.

The IBT report will be generated each month on the Monday following semi-monthly cutoff beginning June 18, 2007 and will be available for viewing on ViewDirect. The report name on ViewDirect is Intermittent Tracking Report and the report ID is LASP6565. These intermittent benefits will no longer be displayed on the Leave Activities and Balances Report.
