**2026 Property Report Cycles - Banking and Financial Organizations**

*This table provides examples of reporting due dates for unclaimed property held by Banking and Financial Organizations. This table does not apply to Life Insurance Companies or general holders.<sup>1</sup> The examples assume a fiscal year end (“As of Date”)<sup>2</sup> of December 31, 2025 and a three-year dormancy.<sup>3</sup>*
